IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

RESOLVE, to Determine the Feasibility of Using Mountainy Pond for a State Park for the Greater Bangor-Brewer Area.

Mountainy Pond; feasibility study. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$10,000 to the Bureau of Parks and Recreation for the purpose of providing for a feasibility study of using Mountainy Pond in the Town of Dedham for a state park for the greater Bangor-Brewer area.

This study shall include, but not be limited to, the effect on water supplies of the Bangor and Brewer Water Districts.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this resolve is to determine the feasibility of using Mountainy Pond for a state park for the greater Bangor-Brewer area and to assure such study will include sufficient precautionary data as to the effect of such a development on the domestic water supplies of the Bangor and Brewer Water Districts.
