STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Appropriate \$40,000 to Youth-in-Action, Inc., of Portland for the Youth Tides Program.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation; Youth-in-Action, Inc. The following funds shall be appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

1979-80

YOUTH-IN-ACTION, INC.

\$40,000

To be used to fund the Youth Tides Program.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill appropriates \$40,000 from the General Fund for the fiscal year 1979-80 to the Youth Tides Program operated by Youth-in-Action, Inc., of Portland. The funds will be used to maintain staff, pay participants wages, and provide space, materials, and program services to operate the Youth Tides Program. Tides is a youth pre-employment training program designed to reach out-of-school and outof-work youth between the ages of 16 and 21. This program is particularly designed to reach the type of youth no other youth program is effectively reaching.
