COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " to H.P. 1177, L.D. 1442, Bill, "AN ACT to Include Teachers in the Hope Training School for Retarded Children in Mexico in the Maine State Retirement System."

Amend the Bill in section 2 by adding at the end a new sentence to read as follows:

'Credit for previous service shall accrue only to the extent that an eligible teacher makes the necessary employee contributions.'

Further amend the Bill by inserting before the Statement of Fact the following:

'Sec. 3. Appropriation. The following funds shall be appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " # to H.P. 1177, L.D. 1442 Fiscal Note

This bill will require an appropriation from the General Fund of \$7,139 for fiscal year 1979-80 and \$7,265 for fiscal year 1980-81. In addition, it will increase the unfunded liability of the retirement system by \$48,166 which would be liquidated over the next 18.1 years.

Statement of Fact

This amendment adds an appropriation and fiscal note to the bill and makes clear that previous service credit must be brought in.
