## STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Include Teachers in the Hope Training School for Retarded Children in Mexico in the Maine State Retirement System.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 5 MRSA § 1001, sub-§ 18, as last amended by PL 1971, c. 622, § 9 is further amended by adding after the first sentence the following new sentence to read:

Public school shall also include the Hope Training School for Retarded Children as of September 1, 1979.

Sec. 2. Credit for previous service. Previous service as a teacher at the Hope Training School for Retarded Children shall be credited as if the employment had been rendered as a state employee.

### STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill includes teachers in the Hope Training School for Retarded Children in Mexico in the Maine State Retirement System as of September 1, 1979.
