SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1263, L.D. 1447, Bill,
"AN ACT to Fund and Implement Agreements Between the State and
the Maine State Employees Association and to Fund and Implement
Benefits for Managerial and Other Employees of the Executive
Branch Excluded from Coverage under the State Employees Labor
Relations Act."

Amend the Bill in section 6 in the 3rd line (same in L.D.) by inserting after the word "prevail" the following: ', except that no money appropriated by this Act shall be disbursed to fund a contract or other collective bargaining agreement which imposes any obligation, express or implied, on the part of any state employee to join or contribute any fee to any union as a condition of continued state employment'

Further amend the Bill in section 6 in the last line (same in L.D.) by inserting after the date "July 1, 1979" the following: ', consistent with the provisions of this section'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to protect any state employee in the bargaining unit from paying any involuntary contribution as a condition of future employment.
