COMMITTEE AMENDMENT" H" TO H.P. 1186, L.D. 1459, Bill, "AN ACT to Authorize the State to Provide Technical Assistance and Legal Assistance to Recipients of Wastewater and Construction Grants."

Amend the bill by striking out all of the last paragraph and inserting in its place the following:

'Whenever any state funds have been disbursed pursuant to section 411 or 412, the state, acting through the Attorney General, shall have a direct right of action against the recipient thereof, or any contractor, sub contractor, architect, engineer or manufacturer of any equipment purchased with these funds, to recover the funds, as well as any federal funds administered by the department for the same purposes, which may be properly awarded as actual damages in an action alleging negligence or breach of contract.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment will allow the state acting through the Attorney General to assist communities in enforcing contracts funded by state and federal grants and where necessary to bring applicable civil court proceedings.
