Amend the Amendment in section 2, on page 4, by inserting
after paragraph C of subsection 1 of that part designated
"\$1652." the underlined blocked paragraph:
"In addition to the ~~existing~~ penalties/ ^{in this subsection} a fine of \$100 shall be
levied for each day the organization is in violation of section
1651."
