Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'Appropriation. The following funds shall be appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the Purposes of this Act.

These funds are for the purpose of establishing an alcoholism residential rehabilitation program.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment alters the bill by restricting the program and the appropriation to one component: An alcoholism residential rehabilitation program at St. Mary's General Hospital in Lewiston. The appropriation is reduced from the sum in the original bill.
