### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

## AN ACT Concerning Payments and Expenses for Facial Disfigurement and Burial Expenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

39 MRSA § 59, as last amended by PL 1971, c. 544, § 135, is further amended to read:

#### § 59. Burial expenses

If the employee dies as a result of the injury, the employer shall pay, in addition to any compensation and medical benefits provided for in this Act, the reasonable expenses of burial, not to exceed \$1,000 the amount of which he would be entitled for 10 weeks of total incapacity at the time of injury and in addition thereto a payment in the sum of \$1,000 to the widow and if no widow, to the children and if no children to the next of kin as incidental compensation.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill changes the maximum burial allowance from \$1,000 to 10 weeks of total incapacity.
