STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Education in Nutrition.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

20 MRSA § 1751, 2nd paragraph, as repealed and replaced by PL 1967, c. 79, § 2, is amended by adding after the last sentence a new sentence to read:

No certificate shall be granted for elementary or secondary school teaching to any person who cannot present satisfactory evidence of training in nutrition.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill requires training in nutrition for teacher certification.
