Amend the Amendment by inserting after the first paragraph the following:

'Further amend the Bill by inserting after the enacting clause the following:

Sec. 1. 1 MRSA §2501, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 492, §1 and c. 547, §1, is amended by adding after the first paragraph the following:

22. Title 22.

A. Title 22, subtitle 7, shall be repealed on January 1, 1982.

Further amend the Amendment on page 7 by striking out all of the first paragraph and inserting in its place the following:

'Further amend the Bill in section 3 by striking out all of chapter 1685, which includes sections designated "§8535." to "§8540." and inserting in its place the following:

CHAPTER 1685

TERMINATION OF PROGRAM

§8535. Repeal and review

This subtitle is subject to repeal under Title 1, section 2501.

The legislative committee having jurisdiction over the review provided for in Title 1, section 2502 shall be the Joint Standing Committee on Health and Institutional Services.'

Further amend the Amendment by inserting at the end before the Statement of Fact the following:

'Further amend the Bill by renumbering sections 1 to 4 to be sections 2 to 5.'

This amendment repeals the provisions of the bill on January 1, 1982.
