COMMITTEE AMENDMENT" A " to S.P. 495, L.D. 1556, Bill, "AN ACT Coordinating Regional and Intercity Public Transportation Programs."

Amend the Bill in section 4, in that part designated "§4209." by adding at the end the following:

'7. Review.

The Commissioner of Transportation

shall establish a Public Transportation Advisory Committee

consisting of not more than 17 members. The members shall

represent individuals, organizations and agencies as described

in this section. The committee shall advise the Commissioner

of Transportation regarding the administration of this section.
