STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to the Marketing of Potatoes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- 7 MRSA § 1017, sub-§ 1, ¶M is enacted to read:
- M. That the applicant or licensee has been convicted of a 3rd violation of the provisions of sections 951 to 957, committed during the year from September 1st to August 31st.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill provides that continual violation of the Maine potato branding law may be cause for revocation or suspension of license under the Maine potato licensing law.
