COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1332, L.D. 1579, Bill, "AN ACT to Redefine the Term "Political Committee" Under the Election Laws."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'<u>21 MRSA §43, first ¶</u>, as last amended by PL 1975, c. 771, §191, is further amended by adding at the end a new sentence to read:

The 2 members of the board nominated by the political committees of the major political parties and appointed by the municipal officers as provided in this section may be members of the political committee nominating them and may be members of a state or county delegation to a political convention.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment permits a member of a board of registration who is enrolled in a political party, is nominated by that party's political committee and appointed by 2 municipal officers to be a member of a state or county delegation to a political convention.
