IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-NINE

AN ACT Establishing Mechanisms to Pinpoint Responsibility and Facilitate Coordination Between the Various Manpower Training and Economic Development Programs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 5 MRSA Pt. 21 is enacted to read:

PART 21

MANPOWER TRAINING AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CHAPTER 405

MANPOWER TRAINING AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

§ 15701. Manpower training and economic development

The Governor shall establish by executive order a council or councils to advise him regarding coordination of the state's manpower training, including vocational-technical education, and economic development programs.

Sec. 2. 10 MRSA § 925, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 548, § 1, is amended by adding at the end a new sentence to read:

The foundation shall keep the Governor and the State Development Office informed about its current plans and activities.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This new draft requires:

- 1. The Governor to establish by executive order a council or councils to advise him on coordination of the state's manpower training, including vocational-technical education, and economic development programs; and
- 2. The Maine Development Foundation to inform the Governor and State Development Office of its current plans and activities.
