SENATE AMENDMENT "C " to SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to S. P. 581, L. D. 1639, Bill, "AN ACT to Make Additional Corrections of Errors and Inconsistencies in the Laws of Maine."

Amend the Amendment in Part B by inserting after section 21-A the following:

'Sec. 22. 20 MRSA §2273, sub-§1, as repealed and replaced by PL 1977, c. 703, §3, is amended by inserting after the 4th sentence the following new sentence: This shall also apply to Maine contract students in dentistry, optometry and veterinary medicine graduating prior to July of 1982.'

Further amend the Amendment in Part B by renumbering the sections to read consecutively according to Title and section.

Statement of Fact

This amendment will continue present law which allows full forgiveness of those dental, optometry and veterinary students graduating prior to July 1982, who return to practice their profession in Maine for 4 years. It is anticipated that the payback clause of the contract will be addressed by the Medical Education Advisory Committee and the Commissioner of Educational and Cultural Services with recommendations to the Legislature by next year for all students in all Senate Amendment "C" to Senate Amendment "B" to S.
