HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1449, L.D. 1647, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Membership of Treasurer of State on
Boards."

Amend the Bill in section 7 by striking out everything
after the amending clause and inserting in its place the
following:

'The authority shall consist of 10 members, including the
Treasurer of State or his designee, ex officio, as a nonvoting
member and the Director of the State Development Office and
8 members at large appointed by the Governor, subject to review
by the Joint Standing Committee on State Government and to
confirmation by the Legislature, for a period of 4 years,
provided that of the members first appointed, 2 shall be
appointed for a term of one year, 2 for a term of 2 years,
2 for a term of 3 years and 2 for a term of 4 years.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment makes clear that the provision for a
designee applies to the Treasurer of State.
