HOUSE AMENDMENT" B"to H.P. 1534, L.D. 1683, Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify the Education Law."

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 5 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 5. 20 MRSA §305, 3rd ¶, 4th sentence from the end, as enacted by PL -1969, c. 440, §2-F, is amended to read:

Each member municipality of the district shall be represented at the meeting to determine the necessity of reconsidering the method of sharing costs by 3 of its municipal officers, school director or directors, and 2 representatives from each municipality chosen at large by its municipal officers.'

## Statement of Fact

This amendment reestablishes that the method of sharing costs must be approved by a 2/3 vote of the district. The bill had required only a majority vote.
