COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 657, L.D. 1696, Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Charter of the Lewiston-Auburn Water Pollution Control Authority."

Amend the Bill in the Emergency Preamble by striking out all of the 6th paragraph.

Further amend the Bill in section 1, first paragraph, 11th line from the end (9th line from end in L.D.) by striking out the words "member of the board" and inserting in their place the underlined words 'Lewiston resident'

Further amend the Bill in section 1, 2nd paragraph, 4th line (3rd line in L.D.) by inserting after the underlined word "mayor" the underlined words 'of Lewiston'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to eliminate confusion created by the language in the bill. This amendment creates a more clear distinction between the appointed members of the Lewiston and Auburn Pollution Control Board. In addition, this amendment more clearly distinguishes between the appointing authorities in each city.
