HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1612, L.D. 1722, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Hunter Safety."

Amend the Bill by adding at the end of paragraph A the following underlined sentence: 'For the purpose of this paragraph, "recklessly" has the same meaning as that set out in Title 17-A, section 10, subsection 3.'

Statement of Fact

The intent of this amendment is to define "recklessly" in the same manner as provided in the Maine Criminal Code.
