STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY

AN ACT to Amend the School Administrative Districts Reapportionment Procedure.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

20 MRSA § 301, 2nd ¶, as repealed and replaced by PL 1973, c. 750, § 3, is amended by inserting at the end the following new sentence:

If the request or petition is received within 12 months before Federal Decennial Census or Federal Estimated Census figures are due to be issued, then the board may wait until after the appropriate census figures are issued before it makes the required finding of fact.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to allow the State Board of Education some flexibility in developing plans for reapportionment of School Administrative Districts under the "one man, one vote" rule
