STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY

AN ACT to Authorize Cutting of Trees on State Park Lands.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA § 602, sub-§ 16 is enacted to read:

16. Forest management. When the activity is not prohibited by limitations on the state's title and would not unreasonably impair the recreational use and values for which the land was acquired by the bureau, harvesting of wood for fuel or other purposes may be authorized by the director.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill would enable the Bureau of Parks and Recreation to authorize the cutting of fuel and other wood on state park lands in cases where the activity would not detract from the park environment or affect recreational use.
