COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1625, L.D. 1735, Bill,
"AN ACT to Limit the Activities Authorized by the Wholesale
Seafood License."

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the
enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6001, sub-§37-A is enacted to read:
37-A. Rigged. "Rigged" means to have on board _____
_____ the equipment necessary to undertake the
activity.

Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §6851, sub-§4, as enacted by PL 1977, c.
661, §5, is amended to read:

4. License limited. A license shall only authorize these
activities at one establishment or with one vehicle, but not on
a vessel rigged to fish.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify language in
the bill.
