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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY

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**AN ACT Concerning the Brake Requirements on Farm Registered Vehicles under  
the Motor Vehicle Laws.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**29 MRSA § 1652, sub-§ 4, ¶ A, sub-¶ (6), last sentence**, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 598, is amended to read:

A 2-axle **or** 3-axle farm truck equipped with such an axle shall, for all weight proposed, be considered a 2-axle **or** 3-axle vehicle.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This section is presently inconsistent with Title 29, section 246, 3rd paragraph, first sentence as amended by PL 1979, chapter 148 in that the intent of the amended section 246 was to exclude a dolly axle without brakes, used on a farm registered vehicle from the number of axles which are counted in registering that farm vehicle. Section 246 became law under this intent and section 1652 was not amended to exclude the dolly axle.
