## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES (Filing No.第-750) 109TH LEGISLATURE SECOND REGULAR SESSION

AMENDMENT" ( to H.P. 1628, L.D. 1738, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Enforcement of the Truck Weight Requirements Under the Motor Vehicle Laws."

Amend the bill in section 5 by striking out everything after the amending clause and inserting in its place the following:

'The operator or owner of any vehicle entering or leaving the State, or operating within the State, who refuses to permit the weighing of such vehicle shall-be-punished-by-a-fine-of-not more-than-\$500-or-imprisonment-for-not-more-than-90-days,-or-by both is guilty of a Class E crime, except that a fine of not more than \$1,000 may be imposed.

This amendment is presented on behalf of the House Committee on Bills in the Second Reader for the purpose of correcting this legislation by properly indicating language to be removed from the law.
