COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1630, L.D. 1740, Bill, "AN ACT to Allow the Commissioner of Marine Resources to Exercise Limited Authority over the Conservation of Atlantic Salmon."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of the title and inserting in its place the following:

'AN ACT to Allow the Commissioner of Marine Resources to Exercise Authority over the Conservation of Atlantic Salmon.'

Further amend the Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

- 'Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6171, sub-§2, first sentence, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 661, §5, is repealed.
- Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §6253, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 661, §5, is repealed.

Statement of Fact

This amendment clarifies the jurisdiction over Atlantic Atlantic Sea Run salmon by repealing the Salmon Commission's authority to make regulations on salmon.
