HOUSE AMENDMENT" 8"to H.P. 1646, L.D. 1756, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Maine Educational Advisory Organizations."

Amend the bill in section 3 by striking out in subsection 9 all of the 2nd underlined sentence and inserting in its place the following:

'The Legislature recognizes the Maine School Management Association, the Maine School Boards Association and the Maine Teachers' Association as such nonprofit advisory organizations, and declares these associations to be instrumentalities of their member school administrative units, municipal and quasi-municipal corporations, with their assets upon their dissolution to be delivered to the Secretary of State to be held in custody for the municipalities of the State.'

## Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide the same rights and privileges to the Maine Teachers' Association as given to the Maine School Management Association and the Maine School Boards Association.
