SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1658, L.D. 1767, Bill,
"AN ACT Concerning Mobile Barber Shops."

Amend the Bill by inserting before the period at the end of subsection 2 of that part designated "§401-A." the following underlined punctuation and words:

', or in any municipality adjacent to a municipality where a licensed barber shop was in operation prior to the issuance of the special mobile barber shop license!

Statement of Fact

This amendment reduces the possibility of mobile barber shops encroaching into areas already served, by excluding them from municipalities adjacent to a municipality already served by a licensed barber shop.
