STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY

AN ACT Relating to Authority of the Town of Crawford to Sell Lots Within its Public Reserved Lands.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Authority of Town of Crawford to Sell Lots Within its Public Reserved Lands. Any conveyance, prior to December 31, 1978, of public reserved lands by the Selectmen of Crawford, acting pursuant to a 1972 town warrant authorizing such sale, shall be deemed a valid transfer of those lands under the authority of the Revised Statutes, Title 13, section 3164, notwithstanding the repeal of that section.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to validate the sale of 6 public lots in the Town of Crawford. The sale was authorized in 1972 but the repeal of the Revised Statutes, Title 13, section 3164, invalidated the sales before the transfers were completed.
