SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to S. P. 683, L.D. 1806, Bill, "AN ACT to Encourage Car Pools and Van Pools."

OF R.

Amend the Bill by inserting before the enacting clause the following:

'<u>Emergency preamble</u>. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the conservation of energy is in the best interests of our State and nation; and

Whereas, the following legislation is vital to meet

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'

Further amend the Bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'
