COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 706, L.D. 1842, Bill,
"AN ACT to Increase License and Examination Fees for Barbers."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of section 1.

Further amend the Bill by renumbering sections 2 to 5 to be sections 1 to 4.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to permit licensed barbers to continue to practice barbering upon patients and residents of hospitals and nursing homes in any suitable place in a hospital or nursing home.
