HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to S. P. 707, L.D. 1843, Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Pay Schedule of Physicians to Include Actuaries."

Amend the Bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

'Fiscal Note

The approved salary schedule for an actuary is approximately \$35,000. This bill will put these positions in a salary schedule which has a top salary of \$57,262 or \$22,262 over the \$35,000 level. The Bureau of Insurance intends to hire 2 actuaries, so the maximum cost of this bill would be 2 x \$22,262 or \$44,525 to a dedicated revenue account.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to add a fiscal note to the bill.
