STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY

AN ACT Relating to the Facilitation of the Collection of Child Support by Exempting Financial Records from Confidentiality Pursuant to the Law of Financial Institutions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. 9-B MRSA \S 161, sub- \S 2, \P \P F and G, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 416, are amended to read:
 - **F.** The exchange in the regular course of business of credit information between a fiduciary institution and other fiduciary institutions or commercial enterprises, directly or through a consumer reporting agency; or
 - G. Any disclosure of records made pursuant to section 226; or
 - Sec. 2. 9-B MRSA § 161, sub-§ 2, ¶H is enacted to read:
 - H. Any disclosure of records made pursuant to Title 19, section 504.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment to the Banking Code allows disclosure of certain financial records to facilitate the collection of unpaid child support payments.
