STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY

AN ACT Providing for the Election of a Deputy Moderator at Town Meetings.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

30 MRSA § 2054, sub-§ 3, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 536, §§ 7 and 8, is further amended by adding after the first sentence a new sentence to read:

If the moderator fails to appoint a deputy, the clerk, or in his absence a selectman or constable, may call for the election of a deputy moderator to act in the absence of the moderator.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide for a deputy moderator at town meetings in the event that the moderator fails to appoint a deputy himself.
