HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1751, L.D. 1867, Bill, "AN ACT

Providing for Administrative Changes in the Maine Revised Statutes

Relating to Taxation."

Amend the bill in section 2 by striking out everything after the amending clause and inserting in its place the following:

term

'Any "term"/used in this Part shall-have has the same meaning as when used in a comparable context in the laws of the United States relating to federal income taxes, unless a different meaning is clearly required.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment is presented on behalf of the Committee on Bills in the Second Reading in order to avoid a conflict between the bill and the Revised Statutes.
