COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 719, L.D. 1869, Bill, "AN ACT Making supplemental Appropriations from the General Fund for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1980 and June 30, 1981, to the Department of the Attorney General for the Defense of Land Claims Asserted by the Passamaquoddy Tribe and the Penobscot Nation."

Amend the bill by striking out the title and inserting in its place the following:

'AN ACT Making Supplemental Appropriations from the General Fund for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 1980 to the Department of the Attorney General for the Defense of Land Claims Asserted by the Passamaquoddy Tribe and the Penobscot Nation.'

Further amend the bill in the Emergency preamble by striking out at $\stackrel{\text{the}}{=}$ end of the 3rd paragraph the following: "and others will become due and payable immediately after July 1, 1980"

Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 1 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
