HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 724, L.D. 1873, Bill "AN ACT to Develop Elderly Congregate Housing in Maine."

Amend the bill by striking out all of sections 2 and 3 and inserting in their place the following:

'Sec. 2. Legislative review. The Joint Standing Committees on Health and Institutional Services and Appropriations and Financial Affairs shall review the payment structure proposed by the Bureau of Maine's Elderly during the 110th Legislature. The committees shall make recommendations as it deems necessary to fund for congregate housing where housing shelter costs are funded by federal housing subsidy programs and the residents contribute 50% of the cost of support services.'

Statement of Fact

Inasmuch as one Legislature cannot bind another and the funds appropriated under this legislation will not, aside for assurances, be actually needed for approximately 2 more years, the intent of this amendment is to remove the appropriation and provide appropriate procedures for funding upon full knowledge of all details of the project.
