SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P.1774, L.D. 1877, Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify the Provisions Relating to Executive Conflict of Interest and to Establish Financial Disclosure requirements for Policy-making Executive Employees."

Amend the Amendment on page 3 in that part designated "§19." in subsection 1 by striking out all of paragraph B and inserting in its place the following:

'B. "Constitutional officers" means the Governor, Attorney General, Secretary of State and Treasurer of State.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to correct the provisions of House Amendment "A" to Committee Amendment "A" (H-839). This amendment requires the Governor to make the same financial disclosure required of other constitutional officers.
