Amend the Amendment by striking out all of the appropriation and inserting in its place the following:

'Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

Notwithstanding provisions prohibiting or restricting the transfer of funds between departments, the funds appropriated under this Act to the Department of Human Services and the Department of Mental Health and Corrections shall be transferred by those departments to the Department of Educational and Cultural Services to be used for the placement of emotionally disturbed children in residential treatment centers.

SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1868, L.D. 1958

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides that the funds being appropriated for the placement of emotionally disturbed children shall be transferred to the Department of Educational and Cultural Services so that one agency rather than 3 can make the necessary allocations.
