SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 766, L.D. 1963, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide Funds for Residential Energy Conservation."

Amend the Amendment in section 1 in the 5th line by inserting after the underlined word and punctuation "<u>conservation</u>," the following: 'owner-occupied one-family to 4-family'

Further amend the Amendment in section 1 in the 6th line by striking out the underlined words "or a housing project"

Further amend the Amendment by inserting after section 1 the following:

'Further amend the Bill in section 1 in subsection 19 in the last line (next to last line in L.D.) by inserting after the underlined word and punctuation "conservation," the following: 'owner-occupied one-family to 4-family'

Further amend the Bill in section 1 in subsection 19 in the last line (same in L.D.) by striking out the underlined words 'or a housing project'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to limit home improvement notes to owner-occupied one-family to 4-family residential units.
