HOUSE AMENDMENT " $\not E$ " to S. P. 770, L.D. 1964, Bill, "AN ACT to Make Corrections of Errors and Inconsistencies in the Laws of Maine."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of section 23. Further amend the Bill by striking out all of the last 2 lines of section 24 and inserting in their place the following: 'When that certificate <u>or registration</u> accompanies the application, a fee of \$2.00 <u>\$2</u> shall be paid for each license.' the

Further amend the Bill by renumbering/sections to read consecutively.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to remove the provision concerning a sworn affidavit in law relating to license of dogs not capable of producing young.
