COMMITTEE AMENDMENT" (To H.P. 1909, L.D. 1976, Bill, "AN ACT to Further Define a Cord of Wood."

Amend the bill in section 2 by striking out all of paragraph A-2 and inserting in its place the following:

'A-2. Fuel wood, when sold loose, shall be sold by the cubic foot, unless other arrangements are made between the buyer and seller.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment deletes paragraph A-2 of section 2 of the bill and replaces it with the provision that loose fuel wood shall be sold by the cubic foot, unless other arrangements are made between the buyer and seller. Other provisions in the bill which removed definitional problems in the weights and measures law are retained. Paragraph A-1 of section 2 makes no change in existing law.
