HOUSE AMENDMENT " 1 to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1917,
L.D. 1982, Bill, "AN ACT to Authorize Deductions from the Term
of Imprisonment of Certain Persons Serving a Split Sentence."

Amend the Amendment by striking out everything after the the first paragraph \longleftrightarrow and inserting in its place the following:

- 'Sec. 1. 17-A MRSA §1203, sub-§4 is enacted to read:
- 4. Each person sentenced to an initial unsuspended term of imprisonment in excess of 120 days under this section for a crime committed on or after July 6, 1978, and on or before September 13, 1979, shall earn deductions authorized by section 1253, subsections 3, 3-A, 3-B and 4.
- Sec. 2. 17-A MRSA §1203-A, as enacted by PL 1979,
 c. 512, §41, is repealed.
- Sec. 3. Effective date. Section 2 of this Act shall become effective 90 days after adjournment of the Legislature.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to include a section omitted in the committe amendment to L.D. 1925, which is necessary to avoid a conflict with that bill relating to sentencing.
