HOUSE AMENDMENT " $\mathcal{B}$ " to H.P. 1936, L.D. 1988, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Periodic Justification of Departments and Agencies of State Government under the Maine Sunset Law." Amend the Bill in Part A by striking out all of section 62. in Part A

Further amend the Bill/by renumbering sections 63 to 80 to be sections 62 to 79.

Further amend the Bill in Part B under the caption "AGRICULTURE, DEPARTMENT OF" by striking out all of the following:

'Positions	(-6)
Personal Services	(83,000)
All Other	(17,900)

Eliminates the appropriation for the State Meat Inspection Program.'

Further amend the Bill in Part B by striking out all of the last line and inserting in its place the following:

'TOTAL PART B - GENERAL FUND

(\$320,800)'

## Fiscal Note

This amendment restores \$100,900 (6 positions) to maintain the state meat inspection program. The amendment thus reduces the General Fund savings in the Bill from \$335,480 to \$234,570.
