STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES (Filing No. H-936) 109TH LEGISLATURE SECOND REGULAR SESSION

Amend the bill by striking out all of the title and inserting in its place the following:

'AN ACT Increasing the Minimum Handling Fee for Returnable Beverage Containers from $l \not \in$ to 20% of Container Refund Value.'

Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'<u>32 MRSA §1866, sub-§4</u>, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 739, §16, .s repealed and the following enacted in its place:

4. Reimbursement by distributor. In addition to the payment of the refund value, the distributor shall reimburse the dealer or local redemption center for the cost of handling beverage containers, in an amount which equals at least 20% of the refund value per returned container.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to change the handling charge for returnable containers from $l \not\in$ to 20% of the container's deposit. This change will benefit both grocery stores and redemption centers by increasing the handling charge.
