HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to H.P. 2003, L.D. 2025, Bill, "AN ACT Adjusting Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government and Changing Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1980, and June 30, 1981."

Amend the bill by striking out all of Part F and by relettering Parts G, H and I to be Parts F, G and H.

Statement of Facts

The intent of this amendment is to retain in the Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 150, the Federal Expenditure Budget.

L. D. 2025, in Part F, repeals the requirement of the to Legislature/appropriate federal funds contained in state programs. If the Legislature ever decides to repeal the Federal Expenditure Budget, a public hearing should be held, or such repeal should at least be proposed via a bill instead of its being added to a supplemental appropriations bill.
