## STATE OF MAINE

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY

#### **RESOLVE**, Authorizing an Appropriation of \$285,315 to Provide for Administrative and Other Necessary Operating Expenses Related to Certain Transitional Indian Services for the Period from July 1, 1980 to January 31, 1981.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the Legislature is considering a negotiated settlement of Indian land claims; and

Whereas, in anticipation of such settlement, no funds have been appropriated to the Department of Indian Affairs to continue essential services beyond June 30, 1980; and

Whereas, the continuity of certain essential services in the areas of public safety, community services, off-reservation services and general administration must be maintained during the period of transition expected to commence upon settlement of these Indian land claims; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace. health and safety; now, therefore, be it

**Division of Transitional Indian Services established. Resolved:** That there be established, within the Department of Finance and Administration, a Division of Transitional Indian Services for the period of July 1, 1980 to January 31, 1981 inclusive; and be it further
