Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved, except section 1 of the Act which shall take effect on July 1, 1980,'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to revise the allocations from the Highway Fund to compensate for the expected shortfall of \$16,700,000 in revenues to this fund for the biennium of July 1, 1979 to June 30, 1981. This amendment eliminates all fee increases in the proposed highway bill and reduces Fighway Fund programs by \$16,694,609.
