STATE OF MAINE SENATE 109TH LEGISLATURE THIRD SPECIAL SESSION

SENATE AMENDMENT "D" to H.P. 2060, L.D. 2041, "AN ACT to Revise Allocations from the Highway Fund for the Fiscal Years from July 1, 1979 to June 30, 1981, and to Provide Increased Revenues to the Highway Fund.

Amend the bill by striking out everything after section l and inserting its place the following:

- 'Sec. 2. 29 MRSA $\S2352$, sub- $\S1$, as repealed and replaced by PL 1975, c. 745, $\S13$, is amended to read:
- 1. Fees. The Secretary of State shall be paid the following
 fees:

A. \$5.00 \$7

- (1) For a certificate of search of the records of the Motor Vehicle Division of each name or identification number searched against; and
- (2) For a certificate of title issued pursuant to section 895-A;

B. \$4-00 \$6

- (1) For filing an application for a first certificate of title including security interest;
- (2) For filing notice of a security interest after the first certificate of title has been issued; and
- (3) For a certificate of title after a transfer;

- C. \$3-00 \$5
 - (1) For a corrected certificate of title; and
 - (2) For a duplicate certificate of title;
- D. \$1.00 \$2.50
 - (1) For each subsequent security interest noted upon a certificate of title:
 - (2) For filing an assignment of a security interest; and
 - (3) For an ordinary certificate of title issued upon surrender of a distinctive certificate.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.



Statement of Fact

The purpose of this bill is to revise the allocations from and increase revenues to the Highway Fund to compensate for the expected shortfall of \$16,700,000 in revenues to this fund for the biennium of July 1, 1979 to June 30, 1981.

This amendment increases certificate of title fees by \$2 on a permanent basis to produce additional annual revenues of \$400,000.

This amendment reduces program allocations in the highway budget.
