COMMITTEE AMENDMENT"6"to H.P. 3, L.D. 3, Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Maine Christmas Tree Law to Include Registration for Transportation."

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'12 MRSA §8848, first sentence, as enacted by PL 1979, c. 545, §3, is amended to read:

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation, for commercial purposes, to transport Christmas trees or-evergreen-boughs from private, state or federal lands to any place or places within or outside this State without first registering with the Bureau of Forestry or persons designated by the Director of the Bureau of Forestry, but no registration will be required of landowners or holders of written permits from landowners for cutting or bundling or hauling such trees and-boughs to roadside.'

## Statement of Fact

This amendment deletes the provision requiring registration for transportation of evergreen boughs.
